Our school initiatives are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2016, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2016 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Develop teacher capability in interpreting and using data to inform teaching practice in the area of Numeracy.
- Build leadership density and teacher capability, across the school, using teachers trained in Anita Archer's 16 Elements of Explicit Instruction, to develop training initiatives supported by coaching, monitoring and feedback processes.
- Strategic placement of an experienced early years' teacher to manage and implement a beginning teachers mentoring program in Semester 1, 2016.
- Enhance early entry Prep readiness through Pre-Prep Program in Term 4, 2016.
- Purchase technology equipment and provide professional development to support the implementation of digital pedagogies in Early Years curriculum.
- Engage the National Institute for Direct Instruction – Spelling Mastery Professional Development.
